During the Teaching & Learning process (in Classroom and Laboratories) and through the student mentoring process, the faculty classifies students as Advanced and Slow learners. The Teacher and the Faculty mentor together analyse the learning abilities of Students/ Mentees based on the indicators such as academic performance and also behavioural, psychological and social aspects.

A) Slow Learners are generally characterized as students with superficial learning abilities, poor / slow grasping power, more absenteeism, with attention issues, sometimes with physical, personal and psychological problems and other developmental and diversified issues.

#### **Characteristics of SLOW Learners:**

- Physical and Psychological problems motor&visual problems, attention deficits, emotional instability, low self-esteem, time and action disorganisation
- Social poor judgement, immature social behaviour, poor concentration
- Personal frustration, aggression, anxiety
- · Academic poor memory, difficulty in comprehension, poor attendance, reluctance to learn
- Developmental issues immature language pattern, speech / hearing issues
- Diversified interest /Weak or ill interest in studies


#### **Action Plan for Improvement:**

- Making the learning process fun, easy to understand and comfortable
- Thorough counselling and mentoring process
- · Repeating the difficult concepts time to time so that it is well understood by the slow learner
- Remedial problem solving sessions



- Conducting target oriented intensive sessions at institute instead of traditional classroom teaching.
- · Providing short and specific direction to students to bring them to level of middle learners
- · Providing extra care during individual based, customized practice session for critical courses
- Students who are assessed to have difficulty with language are given special coaching to improve their language skills.
- · Special classes are taken for every subject by the respective faculties
- Activity based learning is promoted for better understanding of the subject
- Rapid revision of important topics is done prior to the university examination
- Students are encouraged to follow and read text books with simple language for easy understandingand reproducing the same in the exams
- Provision for special notes( lecture topic based handouts ) is given
- Periodical assessment and evaluation are done by giving class tests on short topics
