## **Feedback analysis report 2023-24**

### **Student feedback on UG Curriculum**

The feedback from under graduates was satisfactory. Majority of the students responded positively to the feedback request. Around 50% student were satisfied with the curriculum and syllabi of the course. Around 30 % were neutral regarding the curriculum and the level of knowledge attained by them. Around 20% students were facing difficulty in understanding the curriculum. Few students absolutely disagreed with the curriculum and course content. The students suggested the sessions to be more interactive. They also suggested to include advanced techniques in syllabus.

### **Student feedback on PG Curriculum**

All the students responded positively in the feedback provided. About 15 post graduates submitted the response. There was no disagreement regarding the curriculum. Post Graduates suggested for more advanced technologies & procedures in the PG curriculum. Post graduates should also be properly trained under the supervision of Head faculties to conduct classes for Final year BDS students. More conferences and seminars needed for better exposure.

### **Feedback from faculty**

The faculties provided favourable feedback on the curriculum. Around 70% faculties were satisfied with the course and curriculum . Few faculties disagreed regarding the quality of curriculum and syllabus provided. The faculties suggested for better methods of teaching. They also suggested that UG curriculum needs tremendous improvement in research and updation on current concepts. Measures should be taken to bring a balance between theory and clinical application.

### **Feedback from Alumni**

About 18 Alumni submitted their responses in the feedback provided. They have a favourable response regarding the quality of curriculum. There was no disagreements



but they suggested few ideas to improve it . They suggested to facilitate campus recruitment more and strengthen the placement cell. They also suggested to provide remedial coaching for academically weak students & introduce training programme to improve the employability of students. Also to include more seminars & workshops.

### **Feedback From Professionals**

About 16 professionals gave their valuable feedbacks regarding the curriculum. Few had some disagreements and gave their suggestions to improve it . The suggested that one potential area of improvement could be the inclusion of more practical and real world applications. They also suggested the lab facilities to be more advanced. They opined that ACDSR is good but still have many areas to cover and improve.

### **Feedback from employer**

Feedback collected from employer were satisfactory. They suggested for more proper interaction with patients by the students. The students posted in the departments should politely receive the patients and enquire about their ailments. They expect more University rank holders in the coming years.

After the collection of feedback and suggestions from various stakeholders on the Curriculum , a thorough analysis was done and placed before the management for further discussions and recommendations. The feedbacks will help us to make required changes in the coming academic year.
