#### **ACADEMIC PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION**

The Principal and all Department Heads make the composition of the Academic Monitoring Committee which meets quarterly to address matters pertaining to the institution's academic programmesand college-related activities. The Principal issues a circular to the IQAC instructing them to develop the college's potential plan for the forthcoming academic year prior to the commencement of the Academic Year .



The IQAC sends a notice to all department heads prior to the start of the academic year asking them to complete the following and submit it for approval and adoption to the IQAC.

- 1. Integration of the department's timetable with the master timetable.
- 2. Department requirements as well as the Strategic Perspective Plans .
- 3. The teacher's workload and the requirements for the upcoming academic year.
- 4. Departmental Activities with tentative date of conduct for the academic year

- 5. The syllabus and curriculum for the certification course/Add-on course, the remedial intervention strategies for the courses, and the bridge course.
- 6. The plan for the curriculum, the deployment strategy, and the methods for delivering the curriculum.

#### **COURSE DELIVERY**

- The subject teachers develop Year Plan & Teaching Schedules (Theory& Practical) prior to the beginning of each year as part of the preparation for the delivery of the course.
- All faculty members are responsible for creating the course which include the syllabus, academic calendar, teaching schedule, Lesson plan, programme outcomes, programme specific outcomes, and course outcomes, as well as assignment questions, Answer Keys, and support for academically slow learners.
- The IQAC frequently checks on the effectiveness of the curriculum's implementation.
   Through the implementation of lesson plans, faculty members provide updates on the status of the syllabus coverage and course delivery.
- IQAC conducts academic audits at the department and institute levels to confirm the accuracy of course, evaluation procedures, and laboratory conduct.
- For students who are struggling academically, remedial classes are offered.
- ICT tools and other educational techniques are utilized to ensure that the course is understood effectively.
- Students' academic feedback is gathered from them based on a variety of criteria in order
  to enhance the teaching and learning process. Feedback is given to the concerned faculty
  so they can take the proper corrective action.
- The course instructing faculty and Head of the Department address student input regarding the portion covering as per the lesson plan and suggestions for improving the teaching and learning process before and after each internal assessment test.

#### **ASSESSMENT**

Institution follows Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur, Kerala guidelines for internal assessment.

#### Continuous internal assessment system

The progress and performance of the students is monitored by theirperformance in attendance, class tests, assignments, clinical labsand internal assessment examinations. Then the marks are entered in the register and displayed on thenotice board. Various parameters are set which assess the core competencies of a

dental graduate. The written exam evaluates the knowledge of the students while practical exam evaluates the knowledge, skill and attitude of the students. A minimum of 50% in each is considered as pass.

The internal exams are conducted thrice for a batchand the pattern of theuniversity exam is followed to familiarise the students with thesame. All examinations are conducted in the examination hall understrict surveillance.

#### **University exams**

**Theory:** candidates should have secured 40% marks in internal assessment for theory & practical separately. The aggregate of internal exams will be taken for final average to be submitted to university exam

Attendance: The candidates should have secured 80% attendance in theory & practical separately.

<u>Criteria for a pass</u>: Theory: - 50% of aggregate of university theory + Internal Assessment + Viva voce

\*(Separate 50% pass for University theory exam is mandatory)

Practical: 50% of aggregate of University practical + Internal Assessment

\*(Separate 50% pass for University Practical exam is mandatory)
